



# Corporate legislation tracker – November 2017

Our corporate legislation tracker highlights key corporate developments coming up and on the horizon.

Implementation date	Developments
9 November 2017	Institutional Shareholder Services (ISS) is inviting comments on proposed new voting policies or policy changes in 13 voting policy areas. One new voting policy for 2018 relates to virtual and hybrid shareholder meetings. Comments are requested by 9 November.
14 November 2017	The Government has proposed new powers to intervene in mergers which raise national security concerns. The consultation is in two parts, the first part closes on 14 November.
30 November 2017	Long stop date for AIM companies to obtain a Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) code.
End of November 2017	The Financial Reporting Council (FRC) will publish amendments to the current guidance for auditors when agreeing to the publication of preliminary announcements of annual results.
Late Autumn 2017	The FRC to undertake a fundamental review of the UK Corporate Governance Code to address some of the Government's proposals contained in the response to the green paper.
15 December 2017	Last date for responses to the Best Practice Principles Group for Shareholder Voting Research consultation on its best practice principles for shareholder voting research and analysis.
